2023 West Viognier is a bright, crisp and fruity wine made in a dry style while also showing the natural flavors of the grape. Viognier (*Vee-on-yeah*) is a grape from the Rhone valley and this vintage shows fruity Viognier aromas such as pineapple and kiwi along with citrus and peach. The flavors expand on the palate giving a round mouthfeel and long finish. Viognier pairs well with seafood, vegetables, chicken and even more spicy dishes. These grapes are grown in gravel loam soil close to Dry Creek in our creek side vineyard.

West Wines is a family winery in Dry Creek Valley, Sonoma County run by Katarina Bonde and Bengt Akerlind since 1998. Our winemaking style weighs heavily on traditional French methods. We have two vineyards, one creek-side on the valley floor and the other 400 feet up on a ridge with beautiful south and west exposure. We practice sustainable farming, minimizing the use of energy and water and using solar power. Between the rows of vines we grow cover crops to create nutrition for the grapes but also flowers who serve as a habitat for beneficial insects for pest control.
